

The Background:

The Building:

A landmark building totalling 3,840sq ft over 17 storeys, 111 Piccadilly is located in the heart of the city centre and a recognisable member of the city's skyline. The building's location is ideal for commuters, next door to Manchester

Piccadilly railway station which handles over 1,000 train movements every day with passengers making more than 22 million journeys to and from the station every year.

The Brief in Brief:

This project involved the refurbishment of several key spaces within this large office building.

The main focus points were to improve internal aesthetics and to enhance the customer experience of the building. Both Brown and Bancroft and Bridge Architects were contracted to create calm, contemporary and exciting office spaces. To ensure business continuity during the refurbishment, the work was carried out in phases.
